Product properties

Kapci 2000 HV is a high viscosity fast drying nitrocellulose-based transparent sealer used for the protection of furniture, wooden articles, and interior woodwork. It offers good filling properties, good leveling, fast drying, and easy standability.

Theoretical coverage: 6-8 m²/kg per a coat

Products for application

Kapci 2000 HV NC Sealer Kapci 526 NC Thinner

Substrate and surface preparation

Sand the surface of solid wood with P80 or P120 sanding paper. Blow off dust and wipe off contaminants (grease, oil, etc.) prior to applying Kapci 2000 HV NC Sealer.

Application

Kapci 2000 HV NC sealer can be applied by spraying or by brush.

Kapci 2000 HV NC sealer can be overcoated with Kapci 1K matt/gloss clearcoat.

18-20 s (F4/20°C)

Number of coats:

Apply 2-3 single coats
Total dry film thickness 40-50 microns



Apply two coats



Flash off time:

5- 10 min between coats



Drying time at 25°C:

Dust free: 10 – 15 min/20°C

Dry to Sand 2-4 h

Color:

Transparent color.

Other tips

- 1. Practical coverage depends on several factors including shape, roughness and porosity of the object to be painted, spraying equipment used, application methods, application conditions, film thickness, etc.
- 2. For best results, it is always recommended to test the products on scrap pieces of wood before start paint job.
